

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

STEP 1: Download document template for *MS Word* or *LaTex* in A4 paper size from <http://www.ieee.org/web/publications/pubservices/confpub/AuthorTools/conferenceTemplates.html>

STEP 2: Write or paste the text of your paper into the template closely following the instructions inside the template. Note that document fonts are prescribed by the template and should not be changed.

STEP 3: Download the WSS2010 paper copyright form from [http://www.ieee.org/publications_standards/publications/rights/copyrightmain.html#sect 2](http://www.ieee.org/publications_standards/publications/rights/copyrightmain.html#sect2). *MS Word*, *pdf*, and *html* versions of the copyright form are available there. Print and sign the form. The signed copyright form may be faxed to WSS2010 at FAX: +39 0187 527 700, or it may be scanned and emailed to WSS2010 (info@wss2010.org) in electronic form.

STEP 4: To ensure compatibility for final publishing with *IEEE Xplore*, please submit your *pdf* file to a compatibility check by PDF eXpress. Go to www.pdf-express.org and use the Conference ID WSS2010x. New users of PDF eXpress should follow the “New Users – Click Here” link. Returning users will require only an e-mail address and the password you created on your first visit. Refer to instructions at that site for procedures regarding converting to compatible pdf, or checking an existing pdf for compatibility. Upon successful check at the pdf-express.org, you will receive an e-mail from “IEEE PDF eXpress Site Services” stating that your file has passed PDF Check.

STEP 5: Now you are ready to submit your paper electronically to WSS2010. Submit by forwarding the PDF check e-mail that you received from PDF eXpress with the checked pdf version of your paper attached to info@wss2010.org.

NOTE1: Final acceptance of the paper requires the registration of the presenting author

NOTE2: All papers will be compiled into a proceedings published on CD and available at the start of the conference.

NOTE3: Papers will furthermore be published on IEEE Xplore after the conference.

NOTE4: Non-presented papers (no-shows) will not be included in IEEE Xplore.
